Mission Statement

The mission of the Dialogue on Race is to create a forum that examines racial issues articulated by the African-American community in Montgomery County, Virginia, and then develops and implements solutions.

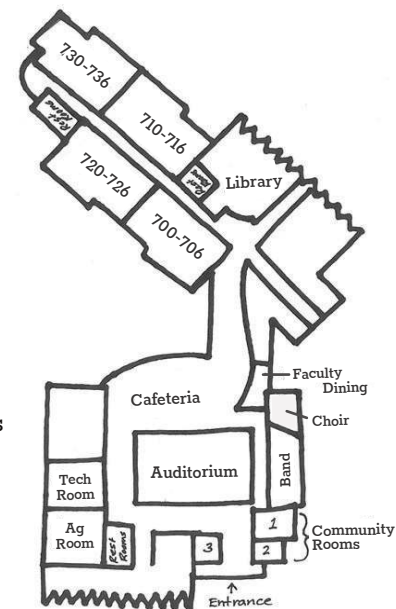
In a series of four focus group type meetings between October 2011 and April 2012, a group of 22-25 African Americans met. In dialogues coordinated by the Steering Committee and facilitated by Dr. Wornie Reed, the participants developed a list of racial issues faced by blacks in Montgomery County: (1) law enforcement, (2) education, (3) jobs and employment, (4) income gap, (5) white privilege and Jim Crow orientations, and (6) the limited presence of African Americans on boards and commissions. These issues formed the basis for the larger community's dialogue, the Dialogue on Race.
